What's on?

Sessions at the Animal Education Centre

Early Years Foundation Stage (age 3 - 5 years)

Science: The Curious Caterpillar

In this story and play session children will be introduced to the very basic lifecycles of animals. We will explore how a caterpillar transforms into a butterfly and using models, discover how other creatures grow.

Maths: Mini-beast Mayhem

In this story and play session we will take a closer look at creepy crawlies. Supporting early maths concepts of matching, sorting, order and number, children will use models of mini-beasts and explore ways of grouping them.



Key Stage 1 (age 5 - 7 years)

Art and Design: Cryptic Colour and Camouflage

Meet Reggie the Red-Eyed tree frog, learn about life in the rainforest and discover why some frogs prefer to stand out from the crowd and others like to blend in. Children will then have the opportunity to make their own frog puppet.

Science and Maths: What's for Dinner?

This multi-activity workshop explores the puzzling world of animal food chains. We will explore what animals need to survive and how all lives (plant and animal) are linked. Children will then take on the task to unravel their own puzzling food chain, creating a paper (food) chain to take away with them.
