This is an easy read guide for booking to visit Ferens Art Gallery and Streetlife Museum.




Ferens Art Gallery is open again.

They are open
Monday to Saturday 10.00am-3.00pm
Sunday 11.00am-2.30pm.



You will need to book a ticket before you come.



It is free to book.

There is a space on the booking form to tell us more about your access needs if you want to.



Print out your ticket and bring it with you.



Or you can show us your ticket on your phone.



Your ticket will have a time on it. This is when you need to come.



If you book over the phone you will be told the time to arrive.



Please be on time. If you are late, you might not be allowed to come in.



You can stay in the museum or gallery for 1 hour.

Up to 8 people can come in for every time slot.



When you book we will ask for contact details for your group.




We will keep these contact details for 21 days.



This is in case you've come close to someone with Covid-19 and someone from the NHS needs to tell you to self-isolate or get tested.



After 21 days we will throw these away.



This is so we can let you know if you have come close to someone who has coronavirus while you were visiting us.

Some things have changed in the museum and gallery.








Maps of the new routes for Streetlife and Ferens Art Gallery
