- When the pieces of fruit escape the supermarket, they could go anywhere in the world. Design and write a postcard from a piece of fruit from a particular destination.
- Write a letter to the supermarket manager explaining how a particular piece of fruit is feeling at being placed in the reject bin.
- Write a motivational speech from 'Bad Banana' to the rest of the fruit in the trolley.
- Write a news article detailing the escape of the fruit.
- Whatever happened to Bad Banana and his friends? Write a sequel to the book, explaining what happened to Bad Banana next.
- Write a recipe and instructions for creating a delicious dessert using the fruit found in the 'reject trolley'.
- Divide the 14 verses amongst the children (in groups of two or three) to perform.
- Write an argument outlining the reasons why large supermarket chains should sell 'wonky' fruit and vegetables.

Maths

- Addition and subtraction at the supermarket, including word problems. *A misshapen banana was put into the supermarket sale. There was 40p off. If the banana was 67p, what is its new price?*
- Percentage sales: working out the price of fruit with 25% off, for example.
- Collect data about your family's favourite fruits and then recording it in pictograms, bar charts or pie charts.
- Ratio: make smoothies. How many grams of strawberries will you need for one person compared to the number of grams of bananas? How many grams of each will you need for 4 people?



Science

- Investigate the effect of placing bananas next to other fruit in the fruit basket.
- Plant your own fruit and vegetable seeds. Which conditions affect plant growth? Which grow the best?
- Which floats, which sinks? Place an unpeeled piece of fruit and a peeled piece of fruit in a bowl of water. Which floats? Which sinks?
- What is the impact of sight and sound on taste?

Art/DT

- Create a still-life of a bowl of fruit.
- Draw cartoon fruit.
- Sketch your own decaying fruit character and model out of plasticine or play-doh.
- Design your own fruit-based recipes and make them, e.g. smoothies, banana bread etc.
- Design 'Do Not Waste' posters.
- Design 'wanted' posters to help the police catch Bad Banana and his friends.

Geography

- Create a compost bin to dispose of your food waste.
- Investigate 'Fair Trade'.
- Investigate the journey of a particular fruit, from farm to supermarket, and its impact on the environment.
