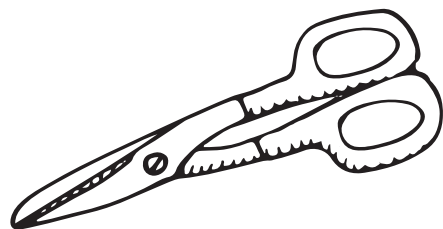

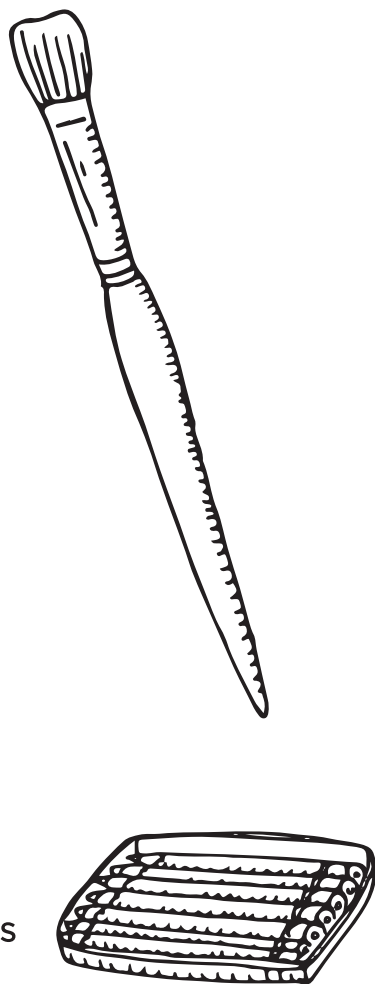
Vouchers will be awarded to the best entries in each of the following age categories:

DETAILS AND REGULATIONS: PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

Who can enter?

Any child aged 15 and under can enter. Entry can be as an individual, or as part of a school or youth group.

How many works can I enter?

Each child can enter one two-dimensional piece. Works should be on paper or card, and can be in a variety of media, e.g. paint, pastel, ink, collage. No framed or canvas works will be accepted. All works will be attached to the wall using Velcro, so please ensure that they are not too heavy. Works should be no smaller than A4 size (210 x 297mm) and no larger than A2 size (420 x 594mm). *NB: schools may submit 35 x artworks maximum. Schools are welcome to submit artwork(s) created by more than one pupil, i.e. a class entry.*

How much does it cost?

Entry is free.

How do I enter?

Deliver your work to Ferens Art Gallery in person or by post (postal entries must include a self-addressed stamped envelope) between **Monday 13 and Sunday 19 December** inclusive (opening hours: Monday-Saturday 10.00am- 4:30pm; Sunday 11.00am-4.00pm). We cannot accept entries before or after these dates.

Please remember to complete your label on the entry form. It's very important that you fill all parts in. Please write neatly using block capitals. Complete the label with name, age, school (if entering as a school) and title of art work. Then attach the label to the bottom left of the artwork. How will I know if my work has been selected?

We will notify you **week beginning 31 January 2022** via e-mail. We aim to show as many entries as possible, submissions from schools will be ensured a minimum of one selection. *Please note we can't accept photographs or photocopies of artwork, only original artworks will be accepted.*

When can I collect my work?

Unselected works must be collected on **Friday 11th or Saturday 12 February 2022** from Ferens Art Gallery*

Accepted works cannot be removed before the close of the exhibition and must be collected between **Monday 6 – Sunday 11 June 2022** inclusive from Ferens Art Gallery*

*Alternatively entries sent by post can be returned to you by post providing you included a self-addressed stamped envelope with your submission. To print a PDF form and label see Junior Open Exhibition 2022 entry details on our website www.hcandl.co.uk.

Please bring your notification of selection email with you as proof of your identity. If your work has been submitted by your school, please contact your school directly to confirm collection arrangements. Ferens Art Gallery reserves the right to dispose of any works not collected by Sunday 11 June 2022.
