Science and Citizenship: An Introduction to Citizen Science

You don't have to be a scientist to contribute to scientific discovery, anyone can do it! Students will explore the different ways in which a hobby or general interest can have the power to influence conservation action. We will look at a variety of projects going on within the local region and offer up opportunity for open discussion as to why these projects are important.
