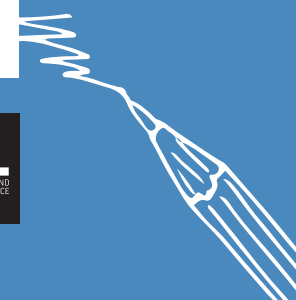

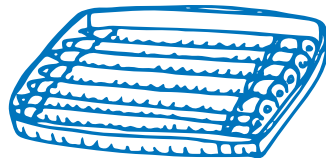
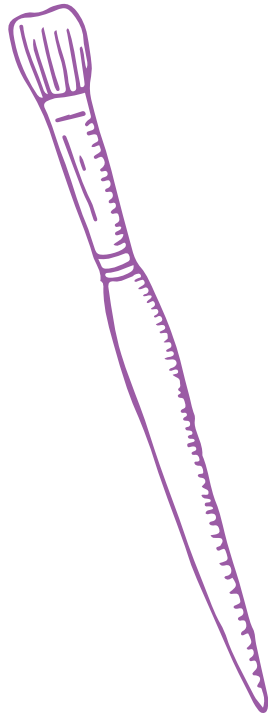

DETAILS AND REGULATIONS: PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

Who can enter?

Any child aged 15 and under on final date for submission (Sunday 11 November). Entry can be as an individual, or as part of a school or youth group.

How many works can I enter?

Each child can enter one two-dimensional piece. Works should be on paper or card, and can be in a variety of media, e.g. paint, pastel, ink, collage. No framed or canvas works will be accepted. All works will be attached to the wall using Velcro, so please ensure that they are not too heavy. Works should be no smaller than A4 size (210 x 297mm) and no larger than A2 size (420 x 594mm). *NB: schools may submit 20 x artworks maximum. Schools are welcome to submit an artwork(s) that has been created by more than one pupil, i.e. a class entry.*

How much does it cost?

Entry is free

How do I enter?

Deliver your work to Ferens Art Gallery between Monday 29 October and Sunday 11 November inclusive (opening hours: Monday-Saturday 10am-4:30pm; Sunday 11am-4pm). We cannot accept entries before or after these dates. Please remember to complete your entry form. It's very important that you fill in both parts and make the information on each half exactly the same. Please write neatly using block capitals.

Attach the entire entry form to the back of your work. Half of it is adhesive. The non-adhesive half of the label will be removed by gallery staff on delivery. Works sent by post must include return postage. Entry forms, if not enclosed with this leaflet, are available from Ferens Art Gallery, Queen Victoria Square, Hull, HU1 3RA. Tel: 01482 300300

How will the works be selected?

We will do our best to show all the entries, but if we do have too many, we will make a final selection. Our decision regarding acceptance and hanging is final. *We will not accept photographs or photocopies of artwork, only original artworks will be accepted.*

How will I know if my work has been selected?

We will send a notification email to you after Wednesday 21 November. We cannot answer telephone enquiries.

When can I collect my work?

Unselected works cannot be collected before letters have been received, but must be collected by no later than Sunday 9 December 2018 from Ferens Art Gallery. Accepted works cannot be removed before the close of the exhibition and must be collected between Saturday 26 January and Sunday 3 February 2019 inclusive from Ferens Art Gallery.

Please bring your notification letter with you as proof of your identity. If your work has been submitted by your school, please contact your school directly to confirm collection arrangements. Ferens Art Gallery reserves the right to dispose of any works not collected by Sunday 3 February 2019.
