# What's on? Sessions at the Animal Education Centre

## **SEND / SEN Sessions (all ages)**

### **Science and Citizenship: Animal Encounters**

Promoting positive connections to animals, we will encounter some of the smaller creatures at the centre. Feeling brave? Students will have the chance to take a closer look at and hold a variety of insect species such as stick insects and cockroaches. There will also be an opportunity to meet some of our more cuddly residents, the guinea pigs.

*This session can be delivered as a simple encounter session for those students with more complex needs, or can be extended to incorporate discussions on living and growing.*

### **Science and Senses: The world around me**

This highly sensory session will allow students to explore the textures, sounds and smells of nature. Ever wondered what it feels like to tickle a tiger? Wondered what animal makes that sound? Or even what a monkey smells like? We will discover all different types of creatures through this highly tactile session.

*This session can be adapted to incorporate further discussion for Foundation and Key Stage 1.*
